#### NOTES TO THE ACCOUNTS

Year ending 31st December 2022:

**1 Subscriptions** The year end accounts record subscriptions paid during the financial year which includes the current years subscriptions and payments received for the following year in advance of 1st January renewal date.

Less had been paid in 2020 in advance of the 2021 season and this distorts comparison of the figures as at 31 December 21 &22. The following figures are annualised. It relate to the subscription year shown, not the accounting year in which paid:

2022: £12 - first aid kit for resumed evening meetings

2021: £72 - Bird boxes in local churchyards and Brooklands.

#### 4 Gifts and Donation made.

Gifts to members retiring from a long term society responsibilities.

#### 5 Postage

Minimal in 2022 as a large stamp stock purchased in 2021

Expense mininised by members kindly volunteering to post bulk mail items in their own localities which they have collected from the membership secretary and at evening meetings. Also postage costs had suffered in 2020 and 2021 due Covid 19 causing extra items to be posted in the absence of indoor meetings until October 2022.

# 6 Information Technology

This will eventually settle at £240 per annum for our recently established commercial database and website facilities. Some additional equipment (leads, etc) was purchased due to the changed venue for our evening presentations and there was additional expenditure arising from Covid 19 restrictions.

#### 7 Public Liability Insurance

This entry includes our Zurich Insurance policy which also provides all risks cover for equipment.

Obtained via membership of British Trust for Conservation Volunteers where we currently enjoy extended free membership.

#### 8 Hire of Hall

Our new venue, St Nicolas & St Mary's Primary School, commenced from October 2022. £45 was an initial fee pending termly invoices.

## 9 Miscellanious receipts

Nil - 2022.

£140 in 2021 was the refund of hall hire for 2020 paid in advance and not used due to Covid 19 restrictions.
