Brief Description: A walk comprising undulating woodland, park land, a quiet village road, and with an option to walk up to the South Downs Way along a rutted footpath. Walks can vary between 1 - 3 miles. Walks should avoid days when Brighton and Hove Albion are playing at home because of huge traffic congestion and parking controls. Parking needs to be paid for (card only) either near the garden centre or more cheaply at the church car park. There are three cafes and public toilets in Stanmer Village. This walk is low risk - but there are some short/steep slopes and a moderate level of fitness and agility is required, especially within the woodland.

Suggested clothing: Warm, waterproof clothing depending on weather conditions; strong footwear or wellington boots
