## NOTES TO THE ACCOUNTS

Year ending 31<sup>st</sup> December 2023:

**1** Subscriptions The year end accounts record subscriptions paid during the financial year which includes the current years subscriptions and payments received for the following year in advance of 1<sup>st</sup> January renewal date. The following figures are annualised. Ic relate to the subscription year shown, not the accounting year in which paid:

#### **3** Miscellaneous Expenditure

#### 4 Gifts and Donation made. £66.98

Gift to a member retiring from long term society responsibilities and thank you gifts for support tasks at evening meetings.

#### 5 Postage & Stationery

Minimal in 2022 as a large stamp stock purchased in 2021

£490.51 in 2023. Predominantly postage but also additional envelopes for the 70 year publication; printer cartridges and laminator pouches for new displays.

Postage expense mininised by members kindly volunteering to post Newsletter and 70 year book in their own localities which they have collected from the membership secretary and at evening meetings.

#### **6 Information Technology**

Website fee: £165.60, User Group fee: £81.98, Database fee: £95.

#### 7 Public Liability Insurance

This entry is our Zurich Insurance policy which also provides all risks cover for equipment. Obtained via membership of British Trust for Conservation Volunteers where we currently enjoy extended free membership.

#### 8 Hire of Hall

Our new venue, St Nicolas & St Mary's Primary School, commenced from October 2022. £45 was an initial fee pending termly invoices. £60 each evening =  $\pounds$ 420 p.annum.
